If you answer "yes" to any question, it does not necessarily mean you (or your child) should not be vaccinated. It just means additional questions must be asked. If a question is not clear, please ask your healthcare provider to explain it.

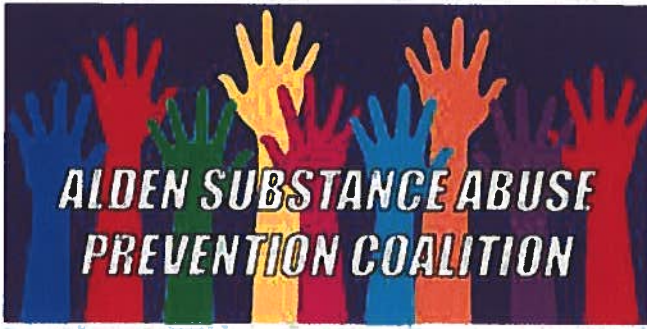

My Dear Diocesan Family,

“Live the Gospel of Life” has been a consistent theme of St. John Paul II and Pope Francis and one that has particular urgency today. This year’s theme for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops’ Respect Life Program fills us with encouragement and hope and calls us to love, defend and celebrate all human life. In Pope Francis’ Day for Life Greeting, he reminds us “Even the weakest and most vulnerable, the sick the old, the unborn and the poor, are masterpieces of God’s creation, made in his own image, destined to live forever, and deserving of the utmost reverence and respect.”

I invite and encourage each of you to join me in prayer on Respect Life Sunday, October 4, 2020 at your parish as we celebrate the Eucharist. We look forward to the opportunity to bless babies, expectant mothers and families immediately after Mass.
