Treasurer's Report:

-Opening balance is \$18,503.74. Pending bills to be submitted, total Fall Fest Deposits totaled \$14,578.25. Total deposits since last meeting total \$17,314.80. Total checks written \$1000.76. Balance in account as of October 27th is \$34,817.78. Minus \$2810.15 in approved appropriated funds, gives a total operating balance of \$32,007.63.

-Jessica also noted that the teachers are using their \$50 for start-up fees. Any teachers that still have not taken advantage of this still have time to submit receipts.

-Also still waiting on candy bar deposit receipts from rectory.
