Dear St. John the Baptist Families,


In response to the increasing positive COVID-19 cases in Erie County, I think that it would be in the best interest of our students to have a practice Virtual Day of Learning. **Tuesday, November 24th** will be reserved for Virtual Learning. I believe that this will be a good test of our digital systems and will be a good indication of how prepared we are as a community in the event another school shut down occurs. Here is a rundown of how this Virtual Day of Learning will occur.

PreK 3, PreK 4, and Kindergarten - All students will attend in person instruction. We have developed a relationship with LE3 that will allow us to function as a child care provider should a shutdown occur. Students will arrive at the normal school time of 7:50 am and will be dismissed at 2:00pm. Students will be able to order lunch as normal this day. **Please note that there will be no bussing on this day.**

1st - 8th Grade - All students will participate in Virtual Learning at home. Classroom teachers will provide a daily schedule of learning that will include independent tasks on Google Classroom and Live class time through Google Meets. Students will bring home their chromebooks on Monday, November 23rd so that they are prepared for virtual instruction.

My sincere hope is that we will not need to use any of these systems, and that we can remain in school for continued In-Person Instruction. I also believe that we have a unique opportunity to prepare our students, and we should use that opportunity.
