Piano, Ukulele, and Guitar Lessons

Lessons Offered and Requirements

<u>Piano</u>

Grades K-8. Students must have a piano or keyboard at home to practice. During lessons, students will be able to use the pianos and/or keyboards available in the music room, which will be disinfected after each use.

<u>Ukulele</u>

Grades 2 - 8. Students must bring their own soprano ukulele for lessons. Ukulele students will also need a digital tuner. Guitar

Grades 3 - 8. Students must bring their own guitar for lessons. Guitar students will also need a digital tuner and an extra set of strings.

Tuition

Tuition may be paid on a monthly or an annual basis. Lesson books are included in the tuition.




